Changes to wattsmart Homes Program in Utah

On December 1, 2016 Rocky Mountain Power (the "Company") received approval in Docket No. 16-035-T13 to shift Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning measures to a Mid-Market channel within the *watt*smart Homes Program. Evaporative cooler offerings will be offered through the Mid-Market channel beginning April 17, 2017, with incentive levels being lowered for the following:
